Application Deadline 4 p.m. March 31, 2017

The CSBG Scholarship is designed, in cooperation with the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, to provide financial assistance to income eligible persons to attend college.

Scholarships will go toward providing formal education or occupational training in an accredited Illinois educational institution to CSBG eligible clients, with particular consideration given to study in high technology areas or other growth occupations.

Education and training made possible through the scholarships include either general education to achieve short-term training (2 years or less) in growth occupation skills, or post-secondary education.

All applicants must be enrolled, or intend to enroll, as a full-time student for the fall 2017 semester in an Illinois accredited college. Full time is considered 12 hours or more.

This is a competitive scholarship based on income and the interview process. Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible. All eligible candidates will be interviewed in June of 2017 and recognized at our Annual Banquet on August 3, 2017.

You must attend a college loan debt workshop if awarded a scholarship.
